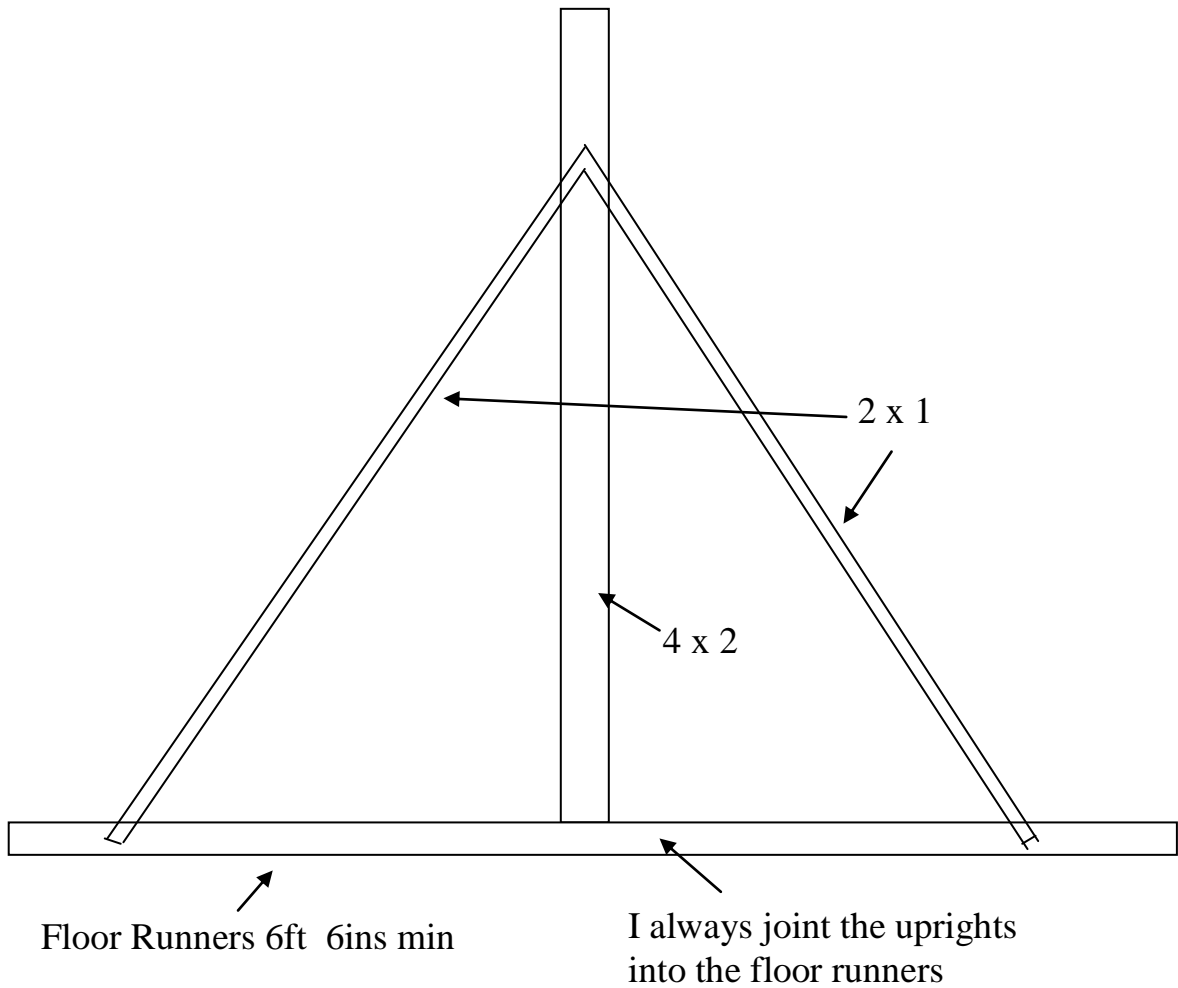


## Scale Construction

This construction isn't the only way of making a scale but it's worked for me often.



Timber size not critical but my preference is 5 x 3 as the weight makes the scale Stable enough for a big dog. Without having to stake down every time you move it.

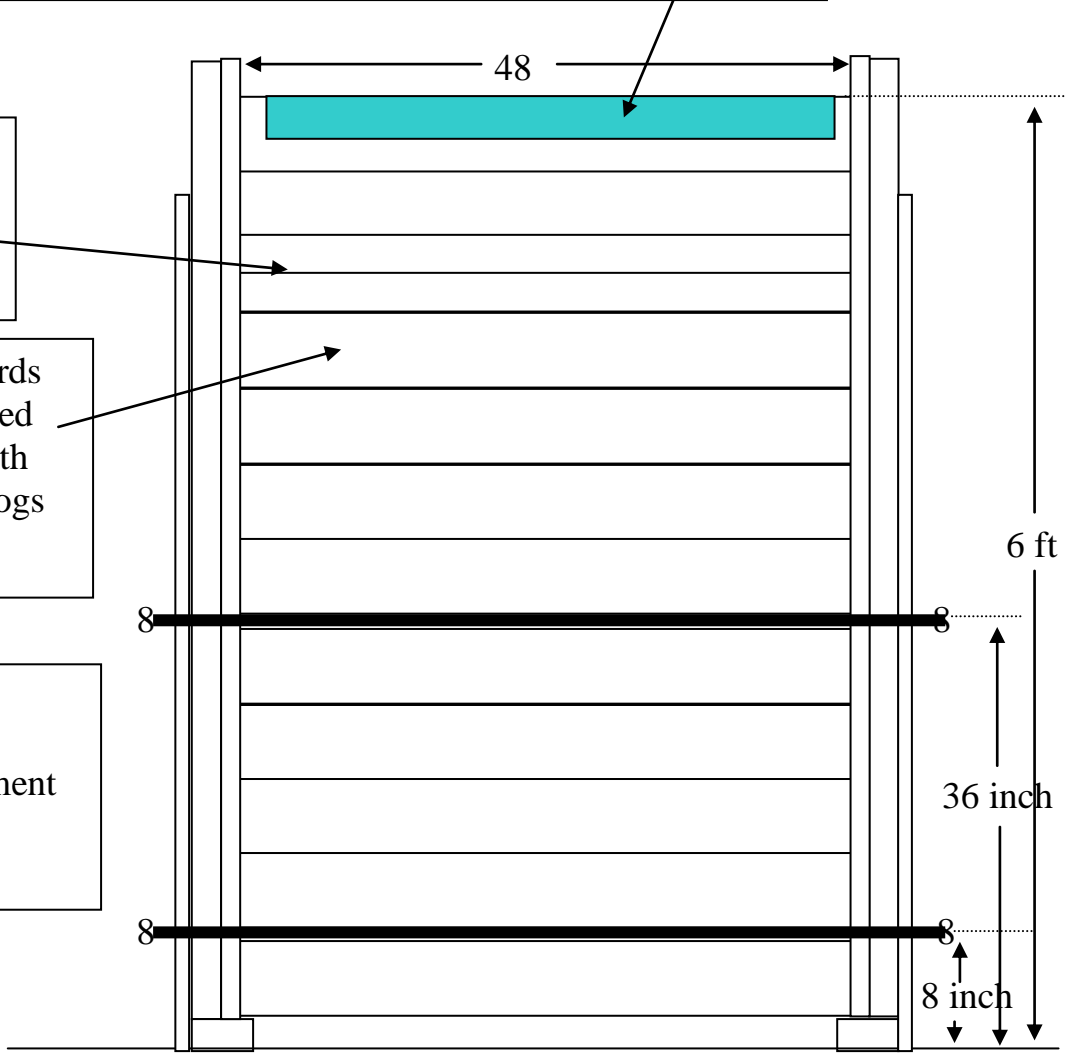
Scale from the front

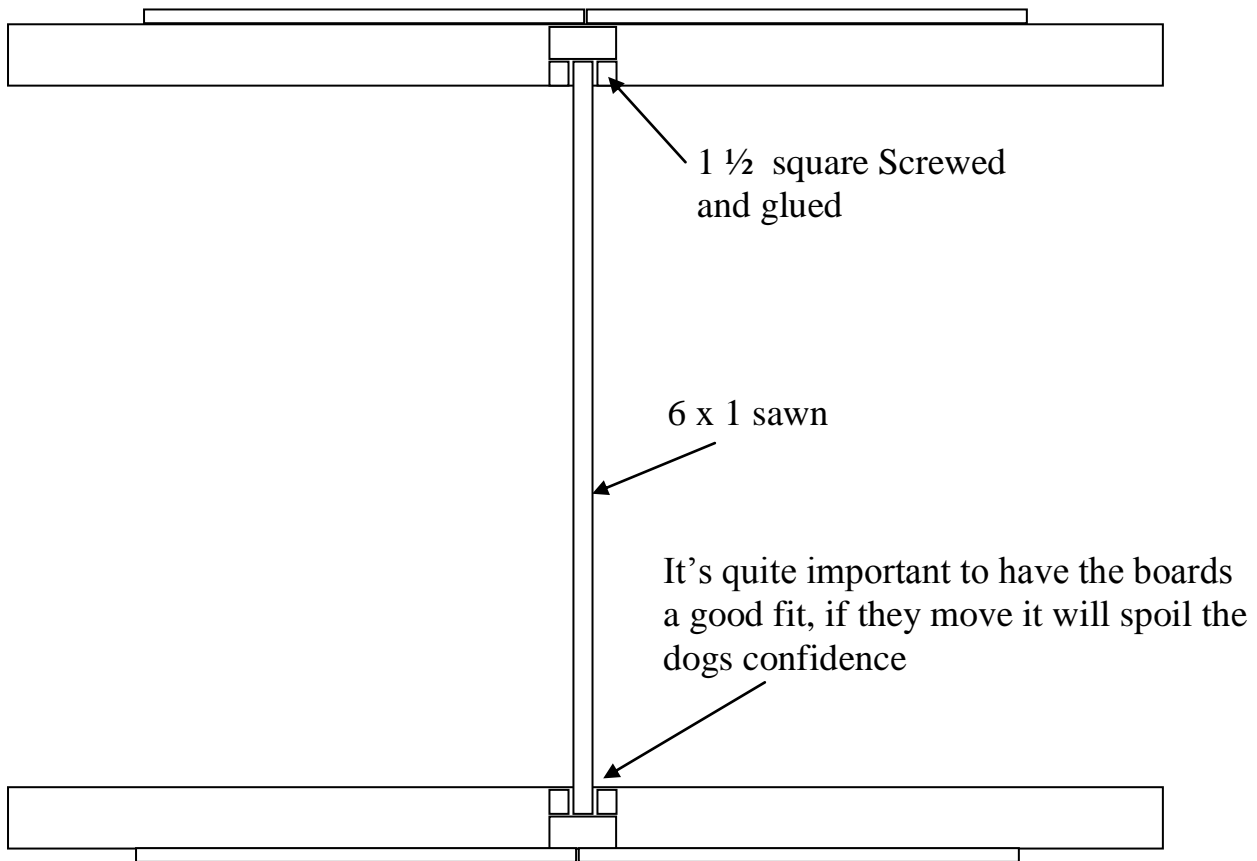
Carpet to soften top edge for the dog screwed in place

1 board needs to be sawn in two to allow gradual increase in height

The 6 x 1 sawn boards  
Need to be chamfered  
On the btm edge both  
sides to allow the dogs  
feet to grip

1/2 threaded Bar  
With some sort of  
wing nut arrangement  
So there are no  
spanners to lose





I usually bolt the joints so the scale can be  
Stripped down later.
